In the immediate future there are some events planned for this congregation that are very important. The upcoming events have been designed and planned with this in mind. The first is our new **Internet Home Bible Study**. This will function much like a conference-call, with students seeing a power point presentation on their computer screens and joining in the study via their telephone. This is a new concept in teaching and reaching out to the lost and we are excited about the possibilities and the doors we hope it will open. We ask that every member be involved in this program by inviting someone to join this Bible study.

The second event will be **May 16**. This is our annual **Friend's Day**. At least one Sunday out of the year we designate Friend's Day and we make a special effort to invite our friends to our services. Of course, we should be extending invitations all the time, but on this day we encourage every one to make a very special effort to bring someone to services with them. There will be nothing different or special about the worship on that day, but this will afford an opportunity to the friends we bring to experience worship following the New Testament pattern. Hopefully you have already made a list of people you want to invite and have sent them an invitation.

The next event planned is our **Summer Series**. This year we are having it on Sunday evenings rather than Wednesday evenings as we did last year. This event is designed to help us in our walk as a Christian to grow spiritually. While the primary purpose is the edify ourselves, we can also use this as an evangelistic tool to invite those who are not Christians to come and worship with us and learn more about God's will for us as we walk with Him. This is something that every member of the congregation should attend. The lessons will focus on helping us to be better Christians as we face the challenges of life. This series will begin on **June 6 and will continue each Sunday evening through August 8**. We have invited several area preachers to be with us for these services and present lessons.
